

## Steve Torchia Memorial Coed Softball Tournament

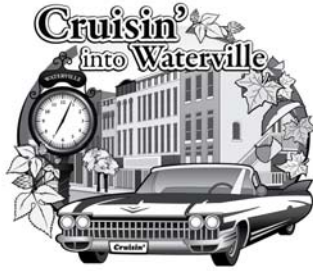
September 18<sup>th</sup> 2010

### Tournament Rules

1. **First and foremost while competitive spirit is welcomed and encouraged, we ask that everyone remember that is a benefit tournament and in above all for FUN. Your sportsmanship will make this event even better. Furthermore field supervisors and event officials will not tolerate confrontational behavior and have the right to dismiss anyone from the tournament at their discretion.**
2. With this being a coed tournament TWO women must be playing at all times both in the field and batting, otherwise the game will be forfeited.
3. Game time- all teams must be ready to play 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time. If able, we may start games 10 minutes before scheduled if time permits. Please be prepared as time is tight and we need to keep things moving.
4. This will be a 3 pitch tournament to save time, this means each batter comes to the plate with 2 balls and 1 strike. A foul ball with 2 strikes is an out.
5. Minimum of 9 players are required to start each game.
6. Courtesy runners - will be allowed 1 per inning but must be done in this order 1 gender equal and 2 most recent player out.
7. This will be a single elimination tournament, with that being said each game will be played in its entirety. There will not be a 15 run rule. We would like to make sure that in the spirit of fun each team gets to play a full game.
8. Home runs- each team gets a maximum of 5 out of the park home runs. After a teams exceeds those 5 home runs all home runs thereafter are outs.
9. Home teams will be determined by a coin flip for each game.
10. Pitching Unlimited arc with a 6 foot minimum.
11. No Metal Cleats or Composite Bats. However half and half bats with a composite handle are OK. NO composite barrels allowed and should be removed from the dugout. All bats that will be used must be place against the fence in the dugout and will be checked by the umpire prior to each game. If a player attempts to use a composite bat it will count as an out and that player will be ejected from the game. If the bat is used a second time it will result in the game being forfeited.
12. All other ASA Standard slow pitch rules apply
13. Any disputes will be resolved by the field supervisor or event organizers and are final.
14. The entry fee of \$110.00 per team must be paid in full prior to team playing their first game.
